New Board Nominations & Updates (Zach Ashley)

Zach Ashley has agreed to step up as Chair for the Nominations Committee. Zach has been a great addition to the committee and will lead this committee forwards!

Zoe Hall has resigned from the Communications Committee and FOM board. Ben Hinnenkamp starts a new job in Philadelphia on Monday and has started his move; he will resign from the Safety Committee and FOM board after this month's meeting. Current open positions in need of co-chairs are Safety, Beautification, Membership/Development, and Comms.

Treasurer's Report (Austin Cheers)

Austin Cheers presented the September Treasury Report. He has changed the way we report from the excel spreadsheets and began using accounting software that has more powerful reporting features. Page one, the balance sheet, tells the committees what they have available to them. On page two, the first column will always be the previous month, and the second column will be the year to date. Page three shows the profit, loss, and net income. Page four shows a breakdown of the previous month and tracks the expenses.

Austin welcomes feedback on what type of information will be helpful, this report is extremely customizable.

Hannah Witwer motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, Autumn Anderson seconded the motion. The board approved the September Treasurer's Report.
