New Board Nominations & Updates (Zach Ashley)

- Molly introduced Erin O'Dea, the new Midtown Action Council/FOM liaison.
- Zach listed the open positions in need of co-chairs: Community Building, Beautification, Membership/Development, Comms. Asked members of committees to provide content about committees for social media posts. Testimonials/accomplishments from past year to highlight to give new board prospects an idea of what it looks like.
- Zach mentioned that in June there will be elections for executive committee positions.
 Molly highlighted that hopefully executive committee nominees will be people currently on the board.

Treasurer's Report (Austin)

- Austin presented January treasurer's report and walked through proposed 2023 budget.
