New Board Nominations & Updates

Molly introduced Erin O'Dea, our Midtown Action Council liaison, who will be sitting in our board meetings to facilitate communication between our two organizations. Our organizations work together on multiple events throughout the year including the Midtown Yard Sale, Verbeke Street Clean Up, and the Holiday Decorating Contest.

Zach presented board member nominee, Ray Yaegel, for the Communications Committee. Ray works for PHEAA and does content development. She was intrigued by our need for a Communications Co-Chair and was interested in volunteering, so she thought this was the perfect opportunity. Cat motioned to approve the nomination, Julian seconded the motion. The board voted Ray Yaegel onto the board of Friends of Midtown.

Zach presented board member nominee, Venus Hawbaker, for the Membership Committee. Venus works with and is interested in branding and promotion. She has many contacts with businesses in Harrisburg through JB Lovedrafts, and is interested in helping to get Friends of Midtown involved with more organizations in our area. Austin motioned to approve Venus, Hannah seconded the motion. The board voted Venus onto the board of Friends of Midtown.

Our current open positions on the board are Community Building, Beautification, Membership/Development, and Safety.

Zach reminded the board that the executive committee terms are up in June and we will be taking nominees for President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Treasurer's Report

We did not have quorum in February at our board meeting, so Austin reviewed the January and February Treasurer's Report for board approval. We are currently at a point in the year where there isn't a lot of money coming in and out, so there wasn't too much to report as far as financials. The board did not have any questions for Austin about the report.

Hannah motioned to approve the January Treasurer's Report, Zach seconded the motion. The board voted to approve the January Treasurer's Report.



Austin mentioned moving the Treevitalize money into the administrative fund. We will vote on this at the next board meeting. The executive committee has been working on budgeting. There were no questions for Austin on the February 2023 Treasurer's Report.

Nate motioned to approve the February Treasurer's Report pages 1 and 2 that is truly the financial position of where we are as of February, Hannah seconded the motion. The board voted to approve the February Treasurer's Report pages 1 and 2. In April we will propose a budget for 2023 and vote on it during our board meeting.

Board members are encouraged to send their budgeting goals for their committee to Austin ahead of our April board meeting. We will discuss what we want our membership numbers to look like in the coming year, discuss fundraising and contribution goals for the year, share planning and unplanned events for each committee, we are expecting to have a 10 - 15% increase in administrative expenses due to inflation.

Membership Report

Nate Lotze presented the up to date membership numbers. Priscilla has been reaching out to the YMCA, JCC, and Night Security to make sure they are still on board with their membership offers. The YMCA has agreed to continue to offer their membership offering. Once Venus is on board, we would like to take a look at what our Sustaining Membership package looks like and what we offer them.

Julian and Cat discussed the website refresh project. Currently the drafted site is not a live link and still needs to be populated with photos and information about the committees, but the framework is there and Julian will share the link below in their committee update.



Board Updates

Erin O'Dea shared that MAC will be working with FOM on the May 21st Midtown Yard Sale. They are also currently working on the primary election debates. They are also planning dates for the Verbeke Street Clean Up. MAC discussed in their last meeting that they have a budget for public safety and are coming up with and considering ideas. Erin requested FOM share feedback on the ideas that came up, the board agreed to review. The ideas they came up with are signs and lights along front street when pedestrians are crossing to Waterfront Park; bicycle safety signs and campaigns; mirrors at hard to see intersections on poles; CPR lessons for the public; Narcan distribution information or training; shredder truck; park fence/gate at Sayford Park to reduce the risk of children running out of the park. Erin will send the board this list to share with the board, MAC's next board meeting is April 5th.

- Signs or lights for crosswalks on Front Street (to allow for safer crossing to Riverfront Park)
- Bicycle safety initiatives (signage or PSA around biking etiquette)
- Water fountain north of Forrester (Provide water for people in Riverfront park north of Forrester.
 Currently the closest water is State Street or north of Maclay)
- Mirrors at hard to see intersections (Convex mirrors to allow for better visibility at intersections, especially 2nd and 3rd Streets)
- CPR lessons for the public
- Narcan distribution / information / training (Narcan is an Opioid overdose treatment)
- Digital recorder for HHA (There is a compatibility issue between the camera and recorder at HHA.)
- Shredder truck event (event to allow neighbors to bring documents that need to be shredded
- Park fence (A gate at Sayford Park to reduce the risk of children running out of the park.)
