## **New Board Nominations & Updates**

The nominations committee is in need of a Nominations Chair. Zach Ashley had volunteered to be interim co-chair but we need to confirm with him. Lindsey Sansoni has resigned from the Beautification Committee, leaving an open co-chair position. Ben Hinnenkamp is moving to Philadelphia and is stepping down from the Safety Committee, leaving an open chair position. Eileen Carson will be stepping down from Friends of Midtown board after 10 years, but would like to remain a super volunteer with the organization. The Treasury responsibilities will begin transitioning to Austin Cheers.

Hannah Witwer motioned to transition the Treasury responsibilities to Austin Cheer. Autumn Anderson seconded the motion. Austin Cheers was voted by the board to be the next Friends of Midtown Treasurer.

## Treasurer's Report (Eileen & Austin)

The board reviewed the Treasurer's Report, Eileen Carson presented for the last time.

Sandi Emery motioned to approve the Treasury report, Nate Lotze seconded the motion. The board approved August's Treasury report.

## **Board Business (vote)**

The board reviewed the <u>August meeting minutes</u> for public release. Eileen Carson motioned to approve the meeting minutes, Ben Hinnenkamp seconded the motion. The board voted to release the August meeting minutes to the public.

Last month we brought up the FOM Quarterly Public Virtual Board Meeting Option that started via COVID since we weren't very active in the community. Since then, we have become more active and have been consistent about posting our meeting minutes on our website. Molly Haragan proposed and



motioned that FOM removes the requirement for quarterly virtual public meetings, Austin Cheers seconded the motion. The board voted to remove the requirement for quarterly virtual public meetings.

Hannah Witwer and Sandi Emery gave a tour of the new Excel sheet, <u>2022 Event Schedule, Comms features</u>, <u>& Ideas Sheet</u>. Molly brought up our last month's meeting with Chad Frey and asked the board if anyone from the board was interested by the conversation and would like to get officially trained and take the lead on the Midtown Map follow up.

Molly also shared about her meeting with Historic Harrisburg Association and their behind the scenes work on resources and their idea for an Old Home Fair. Friends of Midtown would like to collaborate with HHA on a directory full of resources for Harrisburg residents who live in old homes and need help finding resources.
